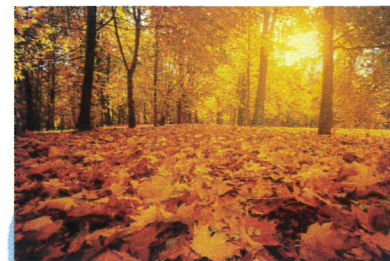
Attendance

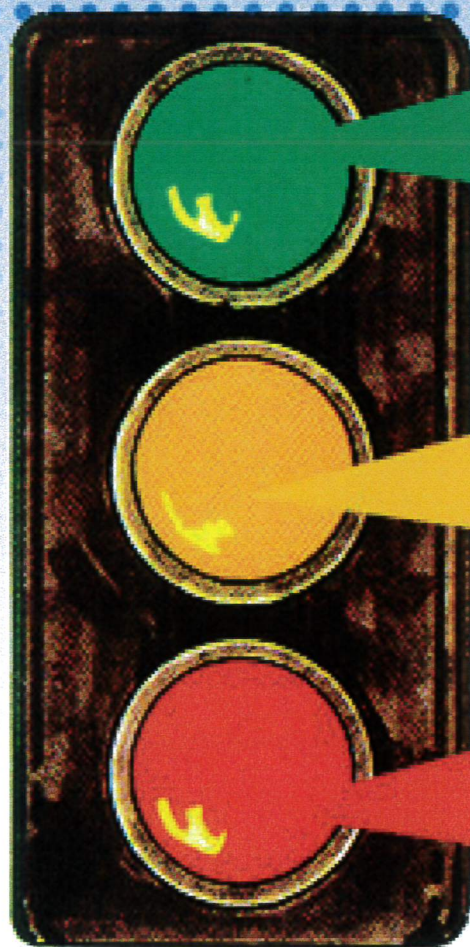
