## Introduction

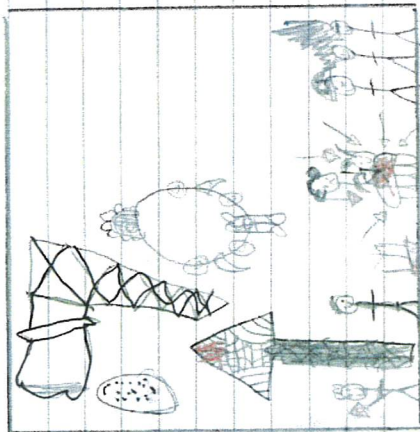
