Online Safety

We support children with online safety in school all the time. There are increasing concerns around children accessing apps which are not age appropriate. It is really important to check that children are not using these social media apps, as the minimum age for these is 13 years old.

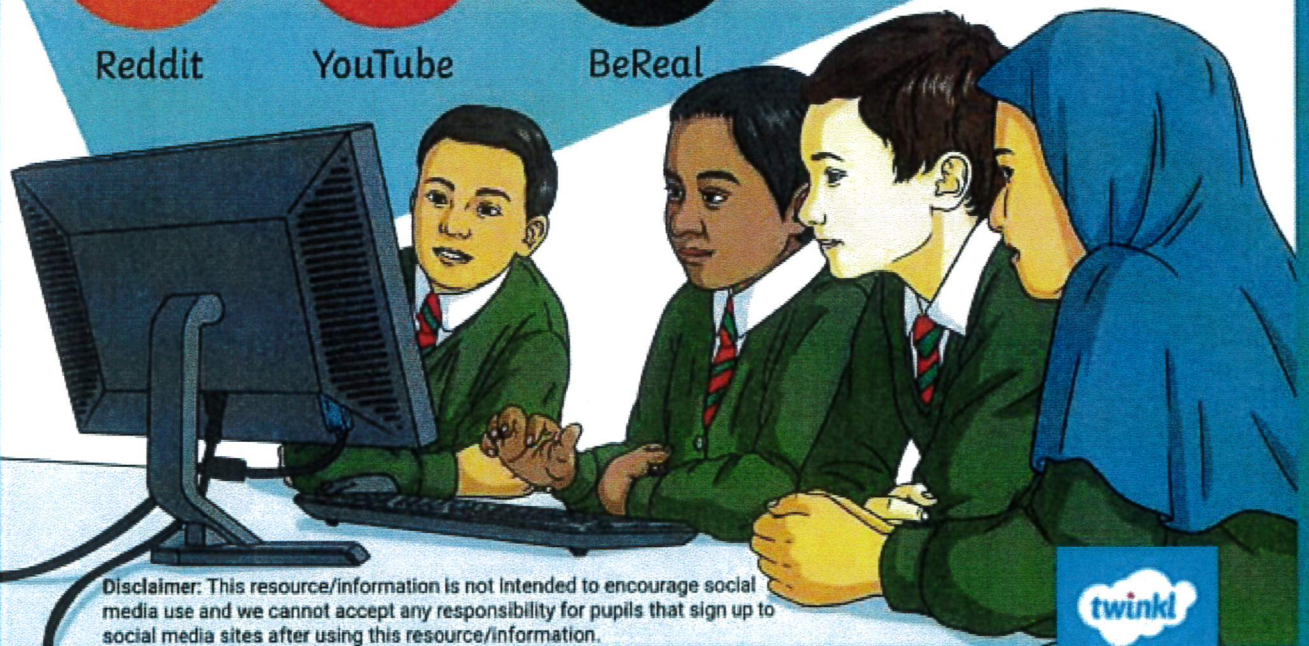
