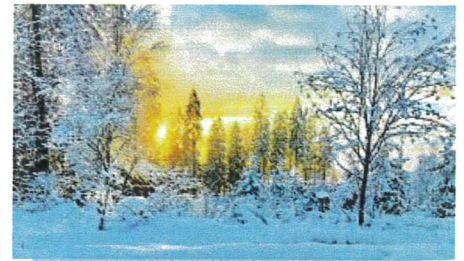




Newsletter
