Dear Parents / Carers

Welcome back to the final term of this academic year. You should have already seen the learning overviews for this term on Class Dojo. This enables you to find out some of the things your child will be learning in class this term.

This week we have had environment week. We had an artist visit us who has worked with classes to create environmental art pieces on topics such as deforestation, pollution and upcycling. We look forward to sharing these in our summer exhibition. The children have also taken part in an environment poster competition and our Eco Committee delivered an assembly on how we can be more environmentally friendly as a school.

We have also had our Ofsted Inspection this week. We cannot share any updates on this at this time as there is a process that follows the visit. Once the final report is received we will share this with you.

A reminder about attendance. We cannot authorise holidays during term time. This means that any holidays taken may result in a fine being issued. Evidence has shown that children with good attendance achieve better both socially and academically. We strive for children's attendance to be above 96%. Attendance that falls below acceptable levels can result in the need for medical evidence being provided when your child is absent or the absence becomes unauthorised. Too many unauthorised absences can also lead to a fine. We want to work with families to support attendance so please speak to us if you have concerns.
