All children have been working extremely hard in class. Here is a small snapshot of some of the current learning taking place:

- ◇ Year 6 have been looking at Electricity in Science, building circuits and investigating what happens when they increase the voltage. They will now be using this knowledge to create fairground rides as part of their DT.
- ◇ Year 5 are looking at space and Earth and are planning shadow investigations next week.
